Notice for the purposes of Subdivision 12-H of Schedule 1 of the Taxation Administration Act 1953 (Cth) Managed Investment Trust non-resident withholding tax Distribution for quarter ended 31 March 2021

The FSREC Property Fund (**FPF**) advises that the distribution for the quarter ended 31 March 2021 was 1.91 cents per unit. The distribution of 1.91 cents per unit was initially announced on 19 April 2021 and is expected to be paid to unitholders on 7 May 2021.

E&P Investments Limited, as responsible entity of Fort Street Real Estate Capital Fund I (**FSRECI**), Fort Street Real Estate Capital Fund II (**FSRECI**) and Fort Street Real Estate Capital Fund III (**FSRECI**) (the **Funds**), declares that the Funds are withholding managed investment trusts for the purposes of Subdivision 12-H of the *Taxation Administration Act 1953* (Cth) in respect of the quarter ended 31 March 2021.
